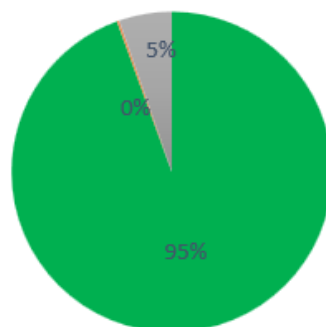
Sovereign Press is committed to ensuring we offer responsible paper choices to our customers. Our choices with paper come in four forms.

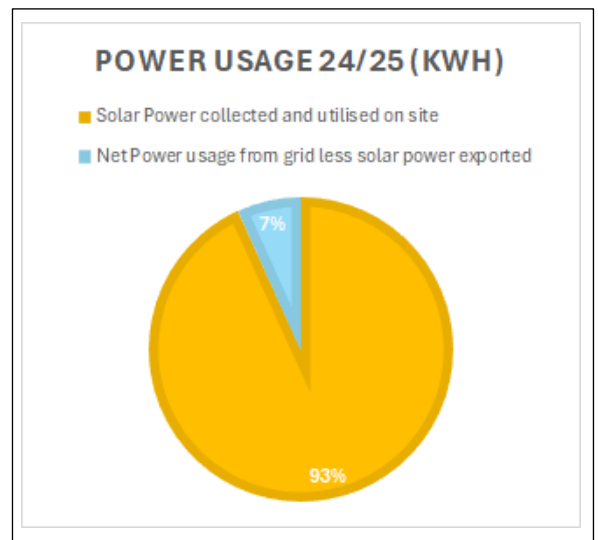

In 2019 we installed a 99kWh solar system on site. Our site operates up to 24 hours a day so we aim to produce enough solar to 100% power our site during day light.

All waste is sorted and managed through a range of services to ensure we are taking responsibility for the amount of waste we produce and how it is disposed of.

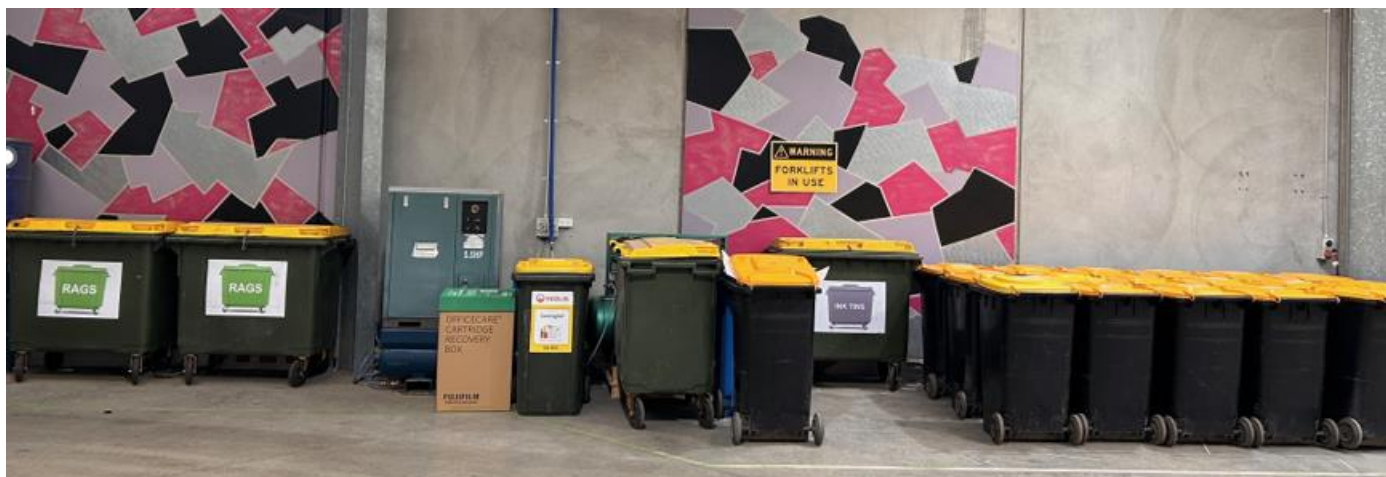
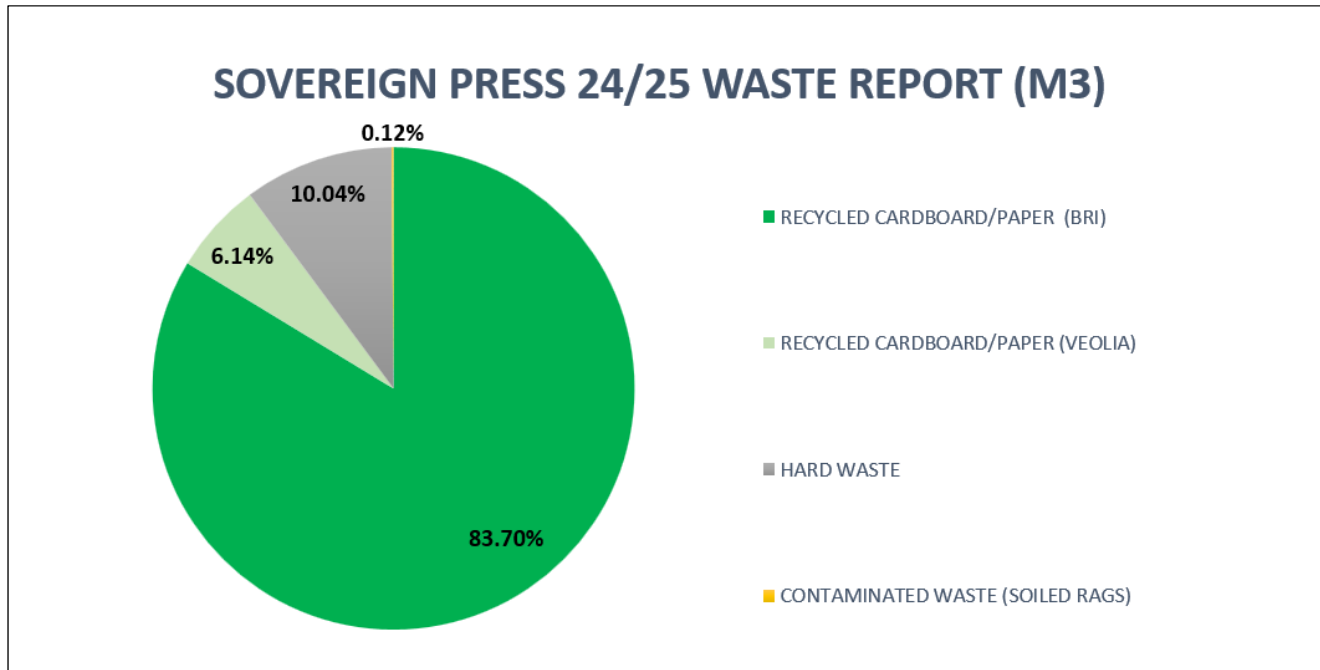
